As part of its 2020 force structure realignment, the Army is considering a proposal that would eliminate 19,800 soldiers and approximately 30,000 civilians. The total is roughly 5% of Honolulu's total population.

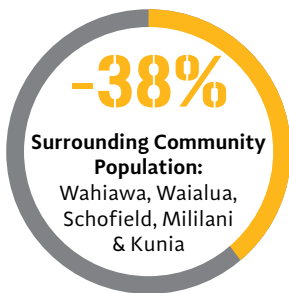
## ARMY FINDINGS

The Army conducted a Supplemental Programmatic Environmental Assessment. It looked at 14 factors.

Results were "minor to beneficial" in all categories except one: **Socioeconomic**.

Air quality	Water resources
Airspace	Facilities
Cultural resources	<b>Socioeconomic</b>
Noise	Energy demand and generation
Soils	Land use conflict and compatibility
Biological resources	Hazardous materials and hazardous waste
Wetlands	Traffic and transportation

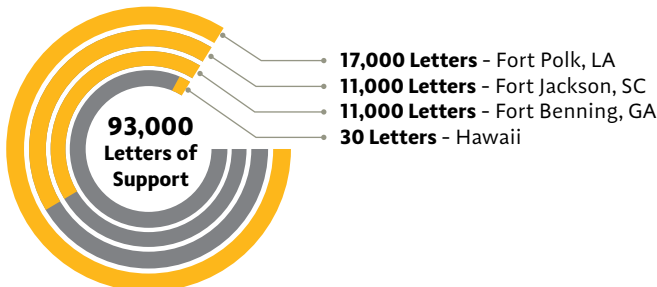
